
Chapter 4 Live / Transportation

Japanese traffic rules may differ from those in your country or region. Make sure you understand the traffic rules to live a safe and secure life.

4-1 Traffic rules



[When walking on a street]



- People walk on the sidewalk located on the right side.
- ② Cars run on the left side of the road.




③ When crossing the road, walk over the pedestrian crossing.

[When riding a bicycle]



① Bicycles usually run on the left edge of the road.

On the sidewalk with the sign "Bicycle allowed," ride near the road on the sidewalk.



 Observe traffic lights at intersections. Go through bicycle crossing lanes.



2 You must stop where there is a "Stop" sign.



④ Do not cross diagonally at the intersection. Make a two-step right turn.




⑤ If you consume alcohol, do not ride a bicycle.



 ⑦ Do not ride while listening to music with headphones.



Do not ride side by side.



1) Do not ride double.



6 Do not ride a bicycle while using an umbrella.



⑧ Do not ride while using a mobile phone.



Do not over speed. Ride at a safe speed.



- ① Turn on the light at night.
- Failure to follow the rules may result in fines and imprisonment.
- If you cause a bicycle accident, you may be liable for damages (need a large amount of money). It is advisable to get <u>bicycle insurance</u>.



- ② Do not park on the road.(It may be cleared up by a collection agent.)






4-3 How to use public transportation

③ Pass through the ticket gate.



※ If you have a transportation IC card, you can pass through by touching the ticket gate with the IC card without buying a ticket.







[How to take a bus]

- ① When the bus fare remains the same, no matter how far you ride (fixed fare)
 - \Rightarrow You usually pay the fare when getting on.
- ② When the bus fare changes depending on the distance \Rightarrow Take a numbered ticket when you get on.

 \Rightarrow When you get off, look at the number on your

numbered ticket and pay the amount shown under the same number on the board in front.

- ※ There are many buses that you can use IC cards. If you have an IC card, touch once when getting on or twice when getting on and off.
- ※ When you get off the bus, press the button to inform the driver.












[Manners when taking public transportation]

① Wait in line on the platform or at the bus stop.



③ On trains and buses, do not speak loudly or talk on the phone.



⑤ Turn off your mobile phone near the priority seat because of the impact on pacemakers.
