

Information for potential applicants wishing to enter Aichi Prefectural Senior High Schools in April 2019 (current third-year junior high school students)

This leaflet is intended for third-year junior high school students and their parents/guardians.

- Entrance examinations for integrated junior and senior high schools
These examinations will be offered at the following integrated junior and senior high schools: Fukue High School (General Course), Shinshirohigashi High School Tsukude Campus (People and Nature Course), and Taguchi High School (General Course and Forestry Course).
(1) Application form submission dates: February 13 (Wed) and 14 (Thur) (2) Interview, etc.: February 18 (Mon)
(3) Announcement of results: February 19 (Tue)
- Make-up tests for general entrance examinations for full-time courses
With the permission of the principal of the senior high school to which you are applying, if you are unable to take the academic tests for unavoidable reasons, such as sudden illness or traffic accident, you may take make-up tests held two days after the respective Group A and B tests. Your junior high school principal must apply for this for you.

Special considerations for applicants with disabilities, etc. (including difficulties due to an illness or accident)

- Your junior high school principal should submit an Application for Consideration in Entrance Examinations to the principal of the senior high school to which you are applying. On the basis of this form, following any necessary arrangements, you will be given special consideration such as appropriate seating during academic tests, interviews, and other screening.
- If you are submitting an Application for Consideration in Entrance Examinations, if you wish you may also submit Self-Report Form B. Your junior high school principal must apply for this for you.

Selection process for students who have been absent from school for long periods, etc.

- A selection process for general entrance to full-time courses, part-time courses, and correspondence courses by students who have been absent from lessons for long periods due to unavoidable circumstances will be offered for all courses at all schools.
- If you wish to apply via this route, please consult your homeroom teacher.

Selection by recommendation for “individuals with an outstanding personality who have overcome their disadvantaged background and are highly motivated to study, whose attitude to life will be a model for others”

- The process of selection by recommendation for full-time courses at Aichi Prefectural senior high schools includes the criterion “individuals with an outstanding personality who have overcome their disadvantaged background and are highly motivated to study, whose attitude to life will be a model for others.”
In this selection process, “disadvantaged background” is defined as the applicant's parent or guardian meeting any of conditions (1) to (3) in the table below, or the applicant himself or herself meeting condition (4), and the supporting documentation required is listed in the “Supporting Documentation” column.
- This selection process comprises a recommendation from the applicant's junior high school principal, after screening by the junior high school at the request of the applicant's parent or guardian or the applicant himself or herself. Students who wish to apply via this route must ask their homeroom teacher and submit the supporting documentation listed below by the date stipulated by the junior high school concerned.

Reason	Supporting Documentation
(1) Public assistance recipient under the provisions of Article 6, Paragraph 1 of the Public Assistance Act (Law no. 144 of 1950).	(1) Documentation issued by the director of the Welfare Office concerned certifying the receipt of public assistance, or previously issued documentation establishing the receipt of public assistance
(2) Person not paying municipal tax or paying only the per capita portion of municipal tax under the provisions of the Local Tax Act (Law no. 226 of 1950)	(2) Certificate of tax exemption, taxation certificate, or notification of the amount of tax collected issued by the mayor of the municipality concerned
(3) Persons receiving child-rearing allowance under the provisions of the Child Rearing Allowance Act (Law no. 238 of 1961) (excluding persons receiving a partial allowance)	(3) Certificate of child-rearing allowance issued by the governor of the prefecture or mayor of the municipality concerned (or the director of a prefectural or municipal Welfare Office)
(4) Persons who have been the subject of measures as children lacking proper care under the provisions of Article 27, Paragraph 1, Item 3 of the Child Welfare Act (Law no. 164 of 1947)	(4) Documentation issued by the director of the Child Guidance Office or child welfare institution concerned certifying that measures have been taken

Notes

1. If reason (2) applies, documentary evidence for both mother and father must be provided.
2. Supporting documentation must be the most recently issued documents at the time the senior high school entrance application is submitted.
3. Documents certifying (2) or (3) may also be used to apply for exemption from entrance fees to prefectural senior high schools, provided there has been no change in circumstances since the previous year. Documents certifying (1) to (3) may also be used to apply for exemption from entrance fees to Nagoya City senior high schools, provided there has been no change in circumstances since the previous year.
